



Marienberg's INIA Tape was developed with the Institute of Agriculture and Livestock Research (INIA) as an effective control system of a type of coleopterous insect: the Naupactus Xanthographus. Along with the INIA 82.4, our tape creates a toxic barrier that prevents the insect from getting to the tree's fruit.

General Characteristics

Does not rot · To be used in conjunction with licensed pesticides as the INIA Paste UV-resistant · Easy to install · Does not smell and is not affected by chemicals.

Main Uses

The INIA Tape (also known as the Burrito Tape) is mainly used in vineyards and fruit trees to keep climbing insects at bay.
